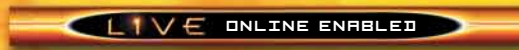

GET READY TO PLAY. CHOOSE ONE OF THESE THREE METHODS TO CONNECT:

Direct Connect

For cable or DSL modems with an Ethernet port, plug your Xbox directly into the modem.

Do this if:

- You can't wait to start playing on Xbox *Live* and plan to set up a home network later.
- You don't mind moving the Ethernet cable between the PC and the Xbox.
- You don't have a PC connected to the Internet.

Router connect

Connect your Xbox and PC to the Internet through a router – an excellent option for most Xbox *Live* gamers.

Do this if:

- You want to play Xbox *Live* and surf the Internet at the same time.
- You don't want to move the Ethernet cable from the PC to the Xbox every time you want to play on Xbox *Live*.
- If you already have a home network set up. Just plug your Xbox into the router.

Internet Connection Sharing (ICS)

Use your PC Windows® ICS to connect your Xbox to the Internet.

Do this if:

- Your broadband Internet service supports USB modems only.
- You prefer buying an internal Ethernet network card or an external Ethernet/USB device for your PC instead of buying and installing a router.

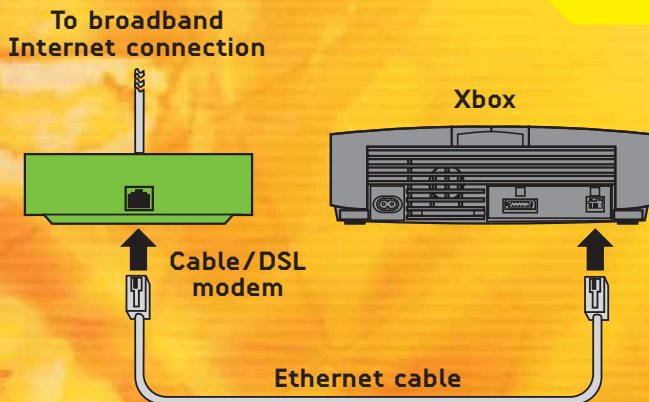

DIRECT CONNECT

Plug your Xbox directly into your broadband modem*.

What you need:

- Broadband modem with Ethernet out.
- Ethernet cable – either a straight or crossover Ethernet cable, depending on the type of modem used**.

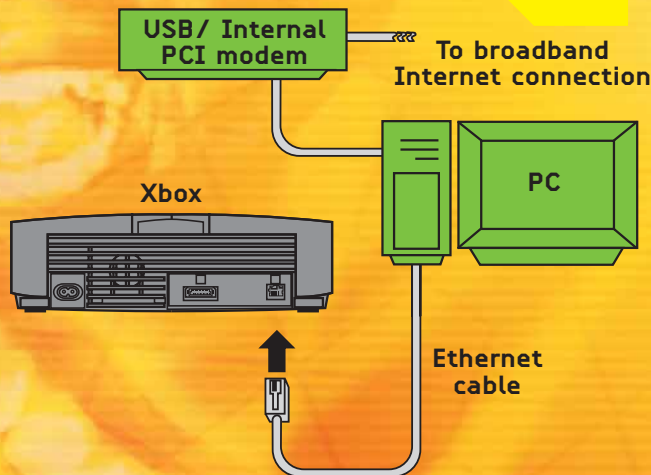
Things to consider:

- This is the quickest way to get connected to Xbox Live.
- It's a great solution if you want to dedicate your broadband connection to Xbox Live.
- The PC and Xbox can't use the Internet at the same time. You will need to move the Ethernet cable from the PC to the Xbox when you want to play on Xbox Live.



INTERNET CONNECTION SHARING (ICS)

Use ICS to connect your Xbox to the Internet.



What you need:

- Unused Ethernet port on your PC.
- Ethernet crossover cable.

Things to consider:

- The PC must be turned on when you use Xbox *Live*.
- The internal or external Ethernet card must be installed unless your PC already has an Ethernet card.
- ICS is a feature of Windows® Millennium Edition (ME), Windows® 2000, Windows® 98SE and Windows® XP*.

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XBOX COMPATIBLE PROGRAM

FAQ

Q A

What's required to get connected to Xbox Live?

- An Xbox console, an Xbox Live Enabled Game, broadband Internet access (cable or DSL), an Ethernet modem or other device to connect to your Xbox, a subscription to Xbox Live and a valid credit card.

What if I don't have broadband Internet access?

- You must have broadband Internet access (cable or DSL). That's number one.
- If you don't have it, get it. Visit www.xbox.com/live, and select your country, for more information.

Can I play the Xbox games I already own on Xbox Live?

- Only if they are Xbox Live Enabled Games. All Xbox Live games will have the Xbox Live Online Enabled bar on the front of the package (see the bar on page 6). If a game doesn't have the bar, it's not enabled for Xbox Live.

Can I use the Xbox System Link Cable as an Ethernet cable?

- A system link cable is a type of Ethernet cable. Depending on your modem, you might be able to use it. See www.xbox.com/live, and select your country, for more information.

What if I want to take my Xbox Live profiles to my friend's house?

- Just save the game to your memory unit* and head on over.

Do I need Xbox Live in order to play Xbox Live Online Enabled Games?

- No, you can enjoy Xbox Live Enabled Games offline as well as online. You might even want to do a little training offline before you begin conquering your online foes...

Why do I need a credit card?

- This is the most efficient way to secure Gamertag authorization.
